From I-95/Ft. Lauderdale Airport/Port Everglades/Florida Turnpike: to I-595 West - Take Exit 5/University Drive, turn right onto University (817 N). Continue to third traffic light and make a left onto Federated Rd., make left @ 1st stop sign and the Hampton Inn is on the right side of the road.

From I-75 - to I-595 East - Take Exit 5/University Drive, turn onto University/(817 N) Continue to the fourth traffic light and make a left onto Federated Rd., make left @ 1st stop sign and the Hampton Inn is on the right side of the road.

When traveling **southbound** on I-95, take exit 261A.

When traveling **northbound** on I-95, take exit 261A

Then proceed east 2 miles on U.S. Highway 92 (International Speedway Blvd.) just past Daytona International Speedway, on the right.

From I-4, take Exit 129 onto U.S. 92 (International Speedway Blvd.) proceed east approximately 4 miles just past Daytona International Speedway, on the right.

From Pensacola go 45 miles on US 98 East. From Mid Bay Bridge to US 98 Bypass go west 1 1/2 miles.

From I-10, take State Highway 85 to Highway 20 E to Mid Bay Bridge to US 98 West for 1 1/2 miles.

NOTE:

2 of your required hours must be a state approved "Prevention of Medical Errors". If this is the first time that you have ever renewed your license, 2 of your required hours must be a state approved "HIV/AIDS" and "Bloodborne Pathogens" class. (1 hour must be HIV/AIDS). Every renewal thereafter only requires 1 hour of approved Bloodborne pathogens.

These required hours can be completed using home study, and can be obtained through any program that is approved for any profession that is regulated under the Dept. of Health. (this means that your cosmetology AIDS course will *not* count for electrolysis renewal).
